To the three winners drawn from all those who participated in the survey. Three children won book tokens:



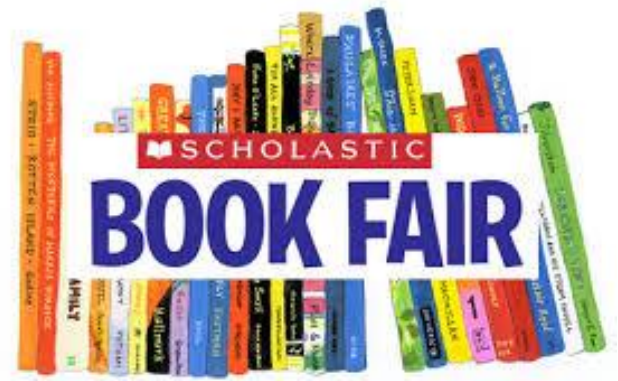
